What is

KosICT started as a regional conference with the aim to bring the global ICT trending topics to the Balkans, by bringing the experience and knowledge of international, regional and local experts, and at the same time promoting the Kosovo ICT sector.



On 12th and 13th of October 2018, the Kosovo Association of information Communication and Technology (STIKK) in partnership with Innovation Centre Kosovo (ICK), Universum College and Connexious, organized KosICT 2018 - which took place at the National Theatre of Kosovo in Prishtina. Topics that covered KosICT 2018 were: Blockchain Technology, AR, FinTech, IoT, VR and AI, E-Commerce, Autonomous Cars, Cloud Computing, Big Data, Bitcoin, 5G etc.

The venue was separated in 4 parts. The Main Stage was where all the speeches and discussion panels were held and attendees had the opportunity to be part of sessions relevant to their fields of interests. Contrary to last year's KoslCT, this year's event also hosted young entrepreneurs in another stage called Dev Stage (Developer's Stage) where they had the opportunity to present their projects in front of a smaller audience. KoslCT also hosted the StartUp fair with ICK where different startups had the opportunity to share their projects and ideas. As addition to creating business opportunities, KoslCT also offered the Business VIP Lounge, as special place for all Investors, CEOs, Directors, etc.

Discussion Panels were a great opportunity to get the attention and engagements of both parties: speakers and audience. The speakers had debates, discussions and communication with the public, while sharing their broad perspective in each topic of their interest.



During the two days of KosICT 2018, there were 27 speakers attending the conference from renowned companies such as EBRD, Ericsson, Medical Valley EMN, Zollhof, Coinrule, Capgemini, T-Mobile Austria, Verso etc. Additionally, KosICT 2018 featured also an exclusive executive business lounge which occurred during the whole two-days on 12th and 13th of October.

KoslCT18 not only gave a chance to the participants to get introduced to business opportunities, but also learn from the stories of some of the most prominent leader figures. The attendees enjoyed the showcases of Kosovo's and international tech companies while taking advantage of the access to network with entrepreneurs, investors, corporate leaders, and innovators.

The conference had an estimate of 1500+ participants.

Opening Speeches

KosICT 2018 was officially opened by the Director of STIKK Ms. Vjollca Çavolli, who welcomed and greeted everyone by emphasizing the constant work and dedication of STIKK and ICT companies in Kosovo. She talked about the achievements reached by STIKK regarding law changing that benefited ICT companies in Kosovo, how ICK was created in 2012 in the same year as KosICT and their improvement so far, the IT strategy that was presented to the government which was later approved and the future plans which focus on creating a Tech Park Project.

The opening remarks continued with the Minister of Innovation and Entrepreneurship Mr. Besim Beqaj, who encouraged young people to stay motivated and work hard in order to create a career in the ICT sector, and therefore create a better future for themselves and for Kosovo. After Minister Beqaj, the Minister of Economic Development Mr. Valdrin Lluka took the stage and promised support for the Kosovo ICT sector, especially for big future projects, such as the TechPark Prishtina, which will create a platform for our society to invest in the younger generation.



The first night of the conference kicked off at the main stage where all the participants got to enjoy the opening speeches and continued with the opening keynote by Alexander Paine from the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD). Mr. Paine shared with us his opinion on how promising the companies in Kosovo are. However, the common thing these companies lack is the Know-How. In addition, Mr. Paine informed the public of KosICT2018 about the EBRD Pilot Acceleration Program which is determined to give appropriate advice and appropriate finance to SMEs. This program will be starting in February 2019.



Main Stage

The opening keynote of Day 2 was given by Sandra Perica Cvjetko, a woman from Croatia coming from Ericsson Company. She talked about the importance of 5G in various industries such as Agriculture, Healthcare, Transportation and so on.

Ms. Cvjetko highlighted that 5G is expected to play a major role in growing industry digitization. A study made by Ericsson in 10 industries and based on 100 case studies concluded that by the end of 2026, industry digitization investments will generate an estimated USD 619 billion revenue opportunity for telecom operators.



The presentation of Ms. Cvjetko was followed by a presentation on E-Healthcare solutions. This presentation was given by Jonas Jung, a young professional from Medical Valley EMN who presented on how healthcare will benefit by implementing digital solutions in various healthcare institutions.

He claimed that as a result of digitization it is estimated that due to early prevention people will live healthier and longer, there will be earlier detection of the diseases, the willingness to invest will be increased, the quality of healthcare services will be improved, there will be more sustainable finance-ability, chronically ill patients will live with less restriction under stable and controlled conditions, AI will support physicians in daily routine and there will be more attractive jobs in all segments.

Overall, digitization will improve the healthcare industry and make it easier for everyone to live a healthier and longer life.



Right after his presentation, Jonas Jung was joined by Çelik Nimani and they both held a discussion where Mr. Nimani was the moderator. When talking about the future and the transformation in E-Healthcare Mr. Jung stated that the E-Healthcare is a complex field considering the fact that there are many areas where this can be developed such as virtual reality processes, wearables and so on. Moreover, for the E-Healthcare to develop it needs to have insights from many fields which need to be developed in the tech area accordingly.

The advice received from Mr. Jung when asked by Mr. Nimani about how developing countries can implement e-healthcare solutions is to leapfrog some steps and learn from mistakes made from developed countries.

What followed was a discussion panel moderated by Tim Sparkman, where the panellists discussed on increasing employability in the Kosovo ICT Sector. The panel consisted of Mr. Driton Hapçiu from Cacttus, Ms. Donjeta Sahatçiu from Rrota, Ms. Hana Qerimi Rizaj from StarLabs, and Mr. Muzafer Shala from Kolegji Universum discussed about the skills gap in the ICT sector. Considering the growth of ICT there is a lack of skilled personnel while the demand from tech companies is high.

Mr. Hapçiu stated that one of the main problems is the quality of education and it usually takes for his company one year of training for new employees. However, companies should invest in these training programs in order to have a better skilled staff.

Ms. Sahatçiu indicated that the Human Index Capital has a 5-year gap with regards to education. Additionally, she stated technical skills can be taught, however, there is a lack of soft skills such as critical thinking and problem solving.

Ms. Qerimi Rizaj denoted that the programming skills, critical and problem-solving skills should be learned from a young age and that the investments should start from elementary school. Furthermore, she mentioned that not only education plays a major role in creative development of young generation but this has also to be encouraged and supported from their families.

Mr. Shala highlighted that university plays an important role to develop skills related to ICT sector. He talked how Universum College has been developing an action plan as a short-term goal which offers internships along studies in order to be able to match the skills of the industry. As a long-term goal they have considered cooperating with secondary school to develop such skills.



After the networking break, Vjollca Çavolli, Executive Director of STIKK held a presentation of the TechPark Prishtina that will be established in Kosovo. TechPark will be a space for startups and tech companies and will serve the needs for the development of ICT sector. TechPark will serve these needs not only locally but regionally and internationally. The beneficiaries of TechPark will be SMEs, senior startups, ICT professionals and students as well as industrial R&D institutions. This will assist in promotion of Kosovo as a country as well as a knowledge-based economy.

Another discussion panel took the stage after Ms. Çavolli's presentation with the topic being, Digital Hubs and Smart Cities. The panel consisted of Vigan Budima who moderated the discussion, Mr. Shpend Ahmeti Mayor of Prishtina, Dr. Robert Couronné from Network for Innovation and Cooperation (NIK), Ms. Judit Klein from Zollhof, and Mr. Ivica Gašparic from Verso discussed the growth of Digital Hubs and the implementation of Smart Cities which are built to enhance the quality of living through smart technologies. Furthermore, the panel tackled the issues of privacy that come from using such technologies.

Mr. Ahmeti signified that governments should provide tools and data to companies so that they can offer innovative solutions. Moreover, Mr. Ahmeti stated that governments should do more to understand what the local companies are capable of. Additionally, some of the examples that city of Prishtina has implemented with regards to technology were discussed.

Dr. Couronné stated that it is important to develop technological solutions for many issues, however, solutions for security effect should be considered too.

Ms. Klein denoted that with the fast development of technology everyday new things are happening and in order to keep moving forward every company needs to be innovative. To accomplish this thought companies, need people with mindset and skills to offer such services.

Mr. Gašparic highlighted that by supporting young companies to develop and providing digital hubs you make entrepreneurship happen. However, in order to have entrepreneurial skills you need to start with education.

With the Blockchain technology and Cryptocurrencies being very actual topics in the technology world still today, we organized another discussion panel consisting of Mr. Oleg Giberstein from Coinrule, Mr. Arnaud Saint-Paul from The Give Foundation, and Mr. Arianit Pajaziti from Blocknify. They discussed about the purpose of cryptocurrencies and the uses of blockchain. In addition, they talked about the challenges of Blockchain, what are the common mistakes and how to avoid them, as well as how it can be used in other areas.

Mr. Saint-Paul explained how Blockchain technology and currencies can be used to create new pathways to help manage money. Furthermore, he stated that this technology does not only help in creating money but it can also be used to have a social and environmental impact. He also showed a video of the Kosovar children thoughts regarding crypto.

Mr. Giberstein highlighted how digital currency serves as an insurance to people opposed to their government monetary policies. Moreover, according to Mr. Giberstein, Blockchain is a great case of decentralization and it is considered to be a game changer. However, what makes people resist using such technologies is its technological complexity.

Mr. Pajaziti explained his success story of using Blockchain and how he established his company named "Blocknify". Furthermore, he talked about how Blocknify uses smart contracts which are mainly functions deployed in Blockchain which offer logic in verifying and checking transactions.



The Blockchain discussion panel was followed by two more discussion panels with the topics being Startup Ecosystem Development and Information Security.

Ms. Leonora Kusari from European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD) and Mr. Uranik Begu from Innovation Centre Kosovodiscussed about the Startup Ecosystem in Kosovo and how it can be developed more. Furthermore, they addressed several issues that startups face in Kosovo.

Ms. Kusari stated that the issue that the entrepreneurs and startups face is that they do not use consultancy companies and experts' opinions regarding their business model before starting their businesses. Furthermore, Ms. Kusari highlighted the importance of consultancy in the ecosystem. Additionally, the importance of education with regards to entrepreneurship and the training to serve the private businesses was addressed.

Mr. Begu stated that in Kosovo entrepreneurship is growing from the necessity and that ICK is trying to be an integrator and facilitator for the companies in need. Furthermore, Mr. Begu stated the importance of startups in providing solutions to local problems and in enhancing the well-being of people in Kosovo.

Mr. Martin Georgiev from CyResLab and Mr. Fatbardh Veseli from Capgemini discussed about the Information Security and its importance on businesses. They talked about the challenges that arise from companies that do not implement Information Security and that each business should implement security design for their specific product.

Mr. Georgiev considered security as a business advantage which will make your product better. Additionally, he stated that companies should care about compliance and take care in-depth about security. Furthermore, he denoted that security is heavily dependent on practice and should be built on knowledge from academia and through experience.

Mr. Veseli highlighted that security is a mandatory thing, however, it is used from companies after they have faced security issues. He also stated how privacy is a basic right in the digital age and it is considered to be the foundation of democracy. Moreover, he advised companies in Kosovo to take the privacy issue seriously and train their employees if they want to provide services to the EU market.



To close out the conference, Driton Emini from T-Mobile Austria gave the closing keynote with the topic "How digitalization shapes our industries". Mr. Emini gave a presentation regarding the usage of 5G and how it will improve the living and many businesses and industries. 5G is considered to be the next 'giant' step in mobile evolution from connecting people to connecting everything. Mr. Emini signified that the solution for today's technological environment is to adapt such change and to not complain but to embrace such technological environment.




